What's Idaho's state flower? *Syringa*

Write scientific name here (two word name under common name): *Philadelphus lewissii*

What family is the Yampah in? *Parsley Family*

Where did the expedition start? *Camp Dubois, Missouri*

Where did the expedition end? *Fort Clatsop on the Oregon coast*

How many plants did the expedition describe? *Around 260 Doesn't our tour information say that they recorded around 260. Do not use the word "discover". It is not politically correct since the Native Americans already knew about those plants. You may say "described" or "collected".*

What is one use of the Prickly Pear (*Opuntia polyacantha*)? *Answers may vary*

What family is beargrass in? *Lily Family*

What is the date the Ponderosa Pine was collected? *Oct 1, 1805*

Give one reason to drink the rose hip tea of the Nootka Rose. *Answers may vary*

Where are the headwaters of the Missouri? *Near Lemhi, Idaho*

The *Holodiscus discolor*, part of the Rose Family and collected May 29<sup>th</sup>, 1806. What's this plant's common name? *Oceanspray*

How many specimens were collected of the Western Serviceberry? *3*

What plant did Lewis use to treat himself? *Chokecherry*

What date was Yellowbell collected? *May 8, 1806*

Name one of "Sacagawea's Plants." *Answers may vary*
