Calling All Artists!

Idaho Botanical Garden is seeking artists to create temporary pieces constructed of natural materials such as rocks, sticks, leaves and ropes made of natural fibers for our Land Art Exhibit. Exhibit runs March 2022-April 2022. \$500 stipend provided to selected artists for materials

Project Overview

The Garden will feature a site specific art exhibit utilizing natural materials such as rocks, sticks, leaves, and ropes made of natural fibers. Exhibits will be created by artists, selected by the committee established by the Idaho Botanical Garden. Each artist will work with Idaho Botanical Garden staff to determine the best location and amount of space best for their work. The exhibit will be open in a time frame that has few special events, and will encourage visitation and more engaged guests. It will take place in March and April in 2022.

No funds will be provided to the artist other than a \$500 stipend. Art is to be installed in early March, 2022 and will remain in place through the end of April, 2022.

2. To apply please submit:

1. artist contact information – phone and email address, mailing address,
2. a written description of what the artist proposes to create,
3. a conceptual drawing or photograph of the proposed artwork is encouraged,
4. the payment schedule required by the artist. Will the artist need money up front to get started?

The Idaho Botanical Garden will look to have a variety of materials represented in the exhibit. A single type of material may be used in a particular piece. Artwork should be able to withstand cold and rainy weather. **Please research examples of land art before submitting a proposal.**
